
Goldilocks and the Three Bears Reading List



Channing, Margot. *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*, 2017. Presents a retelling of the story of a tired and hungry girl, lost in the woods, who finds the house of the three bears and helps herself to their belongings.




Schwartz, Corey Rosen. *Goldi Rocks and the Three Bears*, 2014. In this fractured fairy tale, the Three Bear Band holds tryouts for a lead singer.



Brett, Jan. *The Mermaid*, 2017. Set in the ocean off Japan, this retelling of goldilocks and the three bears stars Kiniro, a mermaid, who finds a baby octopus's breakfast, chair, and bed just right.



Stanley, Diane. *Goldie and the three Bears*, 2003. In this story, loosely based on that of Goldilocks, Goldie, who has yet to find a friend to "love with all her heart," makes an unplanned visit to the house of some bears.



Brooke, Jasmine. *Goldilocks and The Three Bears*, 2017. In this retelling of Goldilocks's classic conundrums, readers use science, technology, engineering, and math to solve problems, such as finding that perfect porridge temperature.
