




Stone Fox. [Gardiner, John Reynolds](#). Crowell 1980

Farmer Boy. [Wilder, Laura Ingalls](#). HarperCollins 1989



Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. [Dahl, Roald](#). Harper Audio 2002


Each of five children lucky enough to discover an entry ticket into Mr. Willy Wonka's mysterious chocolate factory takes advantage of the situation in his own way.




Anne of Green Gables. [Montgomery, L. M. \(Lucy Maud\)](#). Aladdin 2014
