An introduction to poverty and hunger answers such questions as what hunger and poverty are, how people around the world are affected by both, and how readers can help them.




Ellie Engineer Series. Pearce, Jackson. Bloomsbury 2018

When Ellie, who loves to invent and build things, decides to build a doghouse as a gift, she needs to get past the boys-against-the-girls neighborhood feud and ask for help.




#### Lone Stars. Lupica, Mike. Philomel Books 2017

Based on the life of Salva Dut, who, after emigrating to America in 1996, began a project to dig water wells in Sudan.
